



TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS of the MÖLKKY EUROPEAN INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIP 2026



GENERAL INFORMATION

The Mölkky European Indoor Championship (hereafter: EM) is a tournament held under the auspices of the International Mölkky Organisation. It is the **11th edition of the European Indoor Championship**.

The dates of the EM are: **28. 2. 2026 - 1. 3. 2026**. The tournament will be held at the Sportcentrum Měcholupy, Turínská 1483, Prague 10, Czech Republic, on synthetic surface (3 tennis fields). The tennis hall is fully covered and heated.

The EM consists of three separate tournaments:

- Warm-up Tournament (27. 2. 2026)
- EM European Tournament (28. 2. – 1. 3. 2026)
- EM Nations Cup (28. 2. 2026)

In this booklet you will find a whole lot of information about mode, schedule, and execution of the different tournaments of the EM weekend.

PLAYING EQUIPMENT

The tournament will only be played with official Mlkky sets from Tactic Games Oy. It is not allowed to play with equipment other than the ones provided by the organisers, e.g. players' own throwers.

The throwers provided by the organisers will be numbered according to the numbering of the playing fields and, as a rule, must only be used on the lane whose number corresponds to the thrower number. Any changes in this respect can only be made by a main referee. The final match of the EM main tournament will be played with a new Mlkky set and a new thrower.

RULES

Main rules

All EM tournaments shall be played in accordance with the official Mlkky rules as contained in the [Tournament Rules document](#) published by the IMO (version 11.02.2024).

In matches of all EM tournaments, there is no time limit for throwing, unless a referee decides to introduce a time limit for the match. If a time limit is introduced, the time is measured from the moment the team has physical access to the thrower (e.g. by being handed or placed in the throwing area by the referee or the opposing team) when all the skittles have been set upright until the moment the thrower is released from the throwing player's hand. The throwing time includes both consultation within the team and preparation for the throw itself.

The organisers encourage a fair play rule of throwing in a reasonable amount of time, no longer than necessary. If there is a risk of delaying the planned timetable, strict adherence to Rule 9.2 of the aforementioned Official Rules will be required - i.e. a maximum of 60 seconds to make a throw.

Rule 5.7. (37 points) will be also required – i.e. in the event of an error (trespassing, wrong order of players or teams) in situation when team has 37 or more points, their score will drop to 25 points.

BEWARE: Because of the high number of teams participating we had to do a change of rules in order to keep our schedules tight and stable. In the main event and warm up tournament the number of throws will be limited to maximum 12 throws per team (=12 "rounds"). If no team has reached 50 points after 12 rounds, the team with more points wins the set.

e.g.

Team 1:44 points

Team 2: 38 points

Team 1 wins the set 44:38

If there is a draw after 12 rounds, the set will be extended by one round. The team with more points after this very round wins the set, reaching 50 points or 3 misses in a row will end the set immediately without ending the round.

e.g.

After 12 rounds:

Team 1: 42 points

Team 2: 42 points

After round 13:

Team 1: 45 points

Team 2: 47 points

Team 2 wins the set 47:45

BUT

Team 1 - throw 13: 8 points=50 points

Team one wins the set 50:42 straight away, team 2 is not allowed to do their throw 13 anymore.

If it is still a draw after ending 15 rounds, the team which was NOT beginning the set will win.

In all EM tournaments the rule is: 1 player - 1 team. This means that one person cannot play on more than one team within one tournament.

In all EM tournaments, changes of players (within the team line-up) may only take place between sets and matches. No changes in the playing line-up of a team are allowed during a set.

Reminder

Although this EM is an indoor EM, all rules for outdoor EM tournaments apply.

Elements outside the playing area do not count towards the game. That means: if the thrower (Tikku) touches anything OUTSIDE the playing area and THEN knocks down one or more skittles, those skittles are NOT counted as knocked down.

If 1 (or more) skittle(s) flies off the playing area after being hit by a Tikku or other valid playing skittle(s) or lies on the edge or outside the playing area, that skittle(s) is always considered to be knocked down and is counted as such.

Overstepping the mölkkari up front or sideways is prohibited and the throw will be counted as a miss.

In this tournament, only the lower arc throw of the Tikku is allowed.

Order of throwing

In the group matches of the EM Main Tournament and the Warm-Up Tournament, the team written first (top or left) on the scoresheet starts the first set.

In knockout matches of all EM tournaments, the start of the first set is decided by a draw (in non-refereed matches, the teams involved in the match are responsible for conducting the draw - the draw can be conducted, for example, by tossing a coin or a thrower).

In best of 5 games, the order of starting the set will be as follows: ABBA. Only if Team B is leading 2-0 after 2 sets, Team A will start the 3rd set and Team B will start the 4th set if necessary.

In knockout matches of all EM tournaments, the team which throws first in the deciding set shall be decided by the number of points scored in the sets played so far in the match. In the event of a tie in points, a draw is held to decide which team starts the deciding set. It applies to all games including semi-finals and final.

TOURNAMENT

The EM tournaments will be played in the following formats:

1. EM main tournament: 3-player teams (with 1 optional alternate)
Group stage, knock-out stage, B Tournament
2. Warm-Up tournament: teams of 2 (with 1 optional player)
System of 6 rounds, 2 sets per round.
3. EM Nations Cup: teams of 3 (with 1 optional alternate and 1 non-playing captain)
16 teams, knock-out games, all games best of 3.

Information display

Warm-up

A ranking of all teams is updated, by a software, after each round and displayed at the table of main organisers.

EM

A list of all games is posted at the table of the main organizer.

Next to each court there are boards with the record sheets for each game on that court. Teams keep score and take the record sheets to the head organizer's table after the game. Group results will be updated regularly on the global scoreboard on the monitor at the main organisers.

DRAW OF GROUPS, DISTRIBUTION

The group line-ups for the group phase of the EM main tournament will be drawn by organisers and/or one of the main referees.

The EM main tournament draw will take place on Tuesday February 10th at 6 pm CET and will be released on the Organiser's web pages www.euromolkky.cz on Wednesday February 11th

After the draw, it will no longer be possible to modify the composition of a team

Warm-up draw

The 74-team warm-up tournament will be played with each participating team playing 6 matches of 2 sets. A table has been made allocating randomly participating teams before signing the Czech & non-Czech teams to participating teams. Remember, this is a warm-up!

EM Draw

The draws for both the main tournament and the Warm-Up tournament will be held according to the following procedure:

- The 91 teams will be divided into 13 groups of 7 teams
- The 26 Czech teams will be distributed among the 13 groups.
This means that there will be 2 czech teams in each of them.
- Taking into account the non-Czech teams, only Poland have more than 13 teams entered. The draw will be made so that no nation (except Poland) can have more than 1 team in the same group, in the case of Poland there may be 2 teams from the same country in some groups.

Procedure

In order to achieve a harmonious distribution of teams into 13 groups (A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M), teams will be drawn into individual groups from pots created according to the teams of individual nations.

The order of nations will be determined by the first round of the draw, which will first decide the order of the nations drawn.

Subsequently, in the second round, individual teams will be drawn in the order of the drawn nations. That is, it will start with the first drawn nation. After all teams from the first nation have been divided, the draw will continue with teams from the next nation in order, then the third, and so on.

Teams will be assigned to groups as follows: the first team drawn will go to group A, the second to group B, the third to group C, and so on up to group M. Once we reach group M, the next team will go to group A, and so on.

Nation's Cup draw

Due to time constraints, the Nations Cup tournament will be played directly in a playoff system for 16 teams. The first 8 positions in the playoff scheme will be filled according to the current ranking of the country according to the (unofficial) IMO ranking below, compiled solely on the basis of the results of the EM indoor tournaments (calculated over the last 5 years).

Positions 9-16 will be drawn from the remaining teams.

In order to reach a total of 16 teams, 3 additional teams have been added to the 13 participating countries: 1. an international team comprising non-European players, The remaining two teams will be filled by the organizers.

The final result of the 3 added teams will not count towards the national cup.

For example, a final between the international team comprising non-European players and Estonia means that Estonia has already won the national cup.

WARM-UP TOURNAMENT

The Warm-Up tournament involved 74 teams and will be played in the following format:

Each team will play 6 games of 2 sets against 6 different teams.

Each team starts 1 set. Approximately: 30 minutes per game.

Pairs in various categories (women, men, mixed, family) will participate in the tournament.

During the tournament, each pair will play six matches across different categories. After these six matches, the results will be evaluated separately for each category, and the four best teams (in each category) will compete for medals.

Ranking criterias, in that order:

1. Amount of victories (2-0)
2. Amount of sets won
3. Amount of “small points” scored (= total points scored in all games played)
4. Amount of “small points” conceded (= total points conceded in all games played)
5. Mölkkout

EM MAIN TOURNAMENT

The EM main tournament will be played in the following format:

- 91 teams, 13 nations
 - Group stage: 13 groups of maximum 7 teams.
- All group stage matches are two-set matches. Each team will play 6 games of 2 sets against 6 different teams

- Top 48 teams of all teams advance to top 48
- Remaining teams play the B-Tournament

At the end of the group phase, teams will be ranked across the groups according to the following criteria in the order listed:

- a) For each set won, 1 point will be awarded to the team. This means that a team can get a minimum of 0 points and a maximum of 12 points on Saturday.
- b) The next evaluation criterion will be the sum of own small points won in each set.
- c) The third evaluation criterion will be the difference between the sum of own small points and the sum of points played against the team by all opponents.
- d) In the event of a tie and the 3rd criterion, the tiebreaker will be the mölkkout.

The order of teams in 1st – 91st position will then be determined. Group ranking (teams will be divided into individual pots to determine their ranking based on their position in the group. This means that the group winner will be assigned to ranks 1-13 according to other criteria, the second team in the group to ranks 14-26, etc.)

- Seeding for Sunday's knock-out games (teams 1 - 48) will be done according to the following key:

1 plays the winner 32/33

16 vs. winner 17/48, and so on

9 vs. 24/41

8 vs. 25/40

4 vs. 29/36

13 vs. 20/45

12 vs. 21/44

5 vs. 28/37

6 vs. 27/38

11 vs. 22/43

14 vs. 19/46

3 vs. 30/35

7 vs. 26/69

10 vs. 23/42

15 vs. 18/47

2 vs. 31/34

- At the end of the group stage, the teams from all groups advancing to the knock-out stage and progressing to the B tournament will be ranked according to their places achieved in the group stage and then their results.

- The knock-out matches in the main tournament will start with games best of 3 (race to 2), the top 16 teams will play the remaining matches best of 5 (race to 3).
- All the matches of the B tournament are played best of 3 (race to 2)

EM NATIONS CUP

The EM Nations Cup will be played in a play-off phase format. Each country has selected one team (3 + 1 players + non-playing captain) in the tournament. In accordance with IMO documents, the lineups of the national teams of countries with national Mōlkky federations have been decided and passed to the organisers by their national federation. In case of countries without federation, the lineups have been decided among the players from the given country.

In the situation that only 2 players from a participating country are present in the main tournament, they may supplement their national team for the European Cup with a substitute from another country. This player may not represent both countries in the European Cup at the same time.

All matches are played "best of 3" (race to 2).

Ranking games for places 5-16 will be played in addition to the semi-finals, final and 3rd place match.

The first set will start with the team that is listed first on the entry sheet.

In the semi-finals and finals, the draw will decide which team will start the first set.

If the schedule is adhered to, the finals could possibly be played in a "Best of 5" format.

REFERRING

The main referees are responsible for the proper course of the tournaments and their compliance with the rules and will be clearly introduced to the participants before the tournaments begin. The organisers may also appoint additional referees to ensure that the tournaments run smoothly.

Decisions made by the main referees are final.

When a game is supervised by a referee, only the team captains are allowed to talk to the referee.

From quarter finals onward, there will be one referee per match to lift up the skittles.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

EM Indoor perpetual trophy will be handed to the winners. Winners can keep it until the next edition of EM Indoor. A plate with the team's name on it will be applied by its federation, or the team.

Top 3 teams will receive medals for all players, provided by I.M.O.

FOOD AND BEVERAGES

There is a restaurant with a wide selection of hot and cold dishes, a bar with a wide range of drinks and a grill will also be available.

ORGANISER'S PROVISIONS

Security

We rely on each and every player and people present during this event to be responsible. During, before and after the event, please behave: whether in your behaviour, speech and acts.

An automatic defibrillator as well as a first aid-kit are available on the spot. Few volunteers are trained to assist.

Order of matches and fields

Matches of the EM tournaments must take place according to the order and on the fields designated by the organisers. However, a main referee may decide to change the field for a particular match e.g. to speed up the tournament.

Delays

A team which, without a clear reason (e.g. a prolonged earlier match), does not turn up at the field designated for its match within 10 minutes of the designated starting time of the match, loses the match in question by a walkover (each set 0:50).

Alcohol and tobacco products

It is strictly forbidden to bring alcoholic beverages onto the playing area or to consume them in the playing area. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is only permitted in a designated, clearly marked area. It is only allowed to consume alcoholic beverages purchased in the catering stand in the designated area. The penalty for consuming alcoholic beverages outside the designated area is, on the first occasion, a warning for the entire team of the player concerned and, on the second occasion, an outright exclusion of the team from all EM tournaments.

Smoking and heating of tobacco products in the playing area is strictly prohibited. The penalty for smoking or heating up tobacco products in the playing area is, on the first occasion, a warning for the entire team of the player concerned and on the second occasion an outright exclusion of the team from all EM tournaments.

There are cigarettes ashtrays outside the premises by the door. Please use them for that sole purpose and ensure to give a free non-smoking way to people entering and leaving the premises.

Cooperation with organisers, referees, etc.

All participants of the EM tournaments undertake to obey the instructions of the organisers, referees, security personnel and volunteers involved in the organisation of the tournament, as well as to observe the regulations of the venue where the tournaments will be played. Teams whose members do not comply with this obligation may be excluded from the tournament by decision of one of the main referees.

Responsibility

The participants take part in the tournament at their own risk - the organisers are not responsible for any harm to health or loss/damage of participants' property during the tournament.

Facilities

There are several gendered toilets in the area and in the restaurant.
